

CDC will evaluate awardee work plans and budgets for Capability 6: Information Sharing, Capability 12: Public Health Laboratory Testing, and Capability 13: Public Health Surveillance and Epidemiological Investigation in partnership with subject matter experts to better attribute the impact of PHEP funding in relation to public health informatics development.
